Draft Tamaki Open Space Network Plan Consultation



The biggest development in the Tāmaki area will be the delivery of outcomes within the open space network plan, community engagement is our main priority and to date there has been a

lot of positive response. It's good to see some passionate members of the community come out to tell us their issues. The plan is an overall guide to improving the quality and usability of green space, parks and sports field across Tāmaki.

Of course, some people will be affected a lot more than others especially if development happens in a park close to them and development could affect them personally. Consultation on the Draft Tamaki Open Space Network Plan runs from 11th Sept to 8th October 2018.
