**Background:**

2. A wooden bollard and gate was broken and a vehicle also caused damage to the softball playing surface.
3. The Softball Association is gearing up for the playing season and has been disadvantaged by the damage caused.
4. Given the playing season is about to commence it is recommended that the Papakura Local Board approve an emergency one-off grant of \$2,000 to assist the Softball Association with the reinstatement or purchase of equipment for the coming season.
