

Attachment D – Further details of the New Zealand Standard for self-contained vehicles NZS 5465:2001

Requirements of Standard
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• fresh water tanks (12 litre capacity minimum per person). This is to allow for a minimum of 4 litres per person for three days.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• a sink
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• grey/black waste water (12 litre capacity minimum per person). This is to allow for a minimum of 4 litres per person for three days.
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• rubbish bin with a lid
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• a toilet (3 litre holding tank capacity minimum per person). This is to allow for a minimum of 1 litre holding capacity per person for three days.
<p>Amendment to Standard</p> <p>The Standard was amended in 2017 to require a vehicle to have a toilet that can be used inside the vehicle with sufficient head and elbow room when the bed is made up. All new certifications have been required to meet this standard from February 2018.</p> <p>As certification is valid for up to four years, there is a transitional period where there may be some vehicles certified to the old standard through to early 2021.</p>
