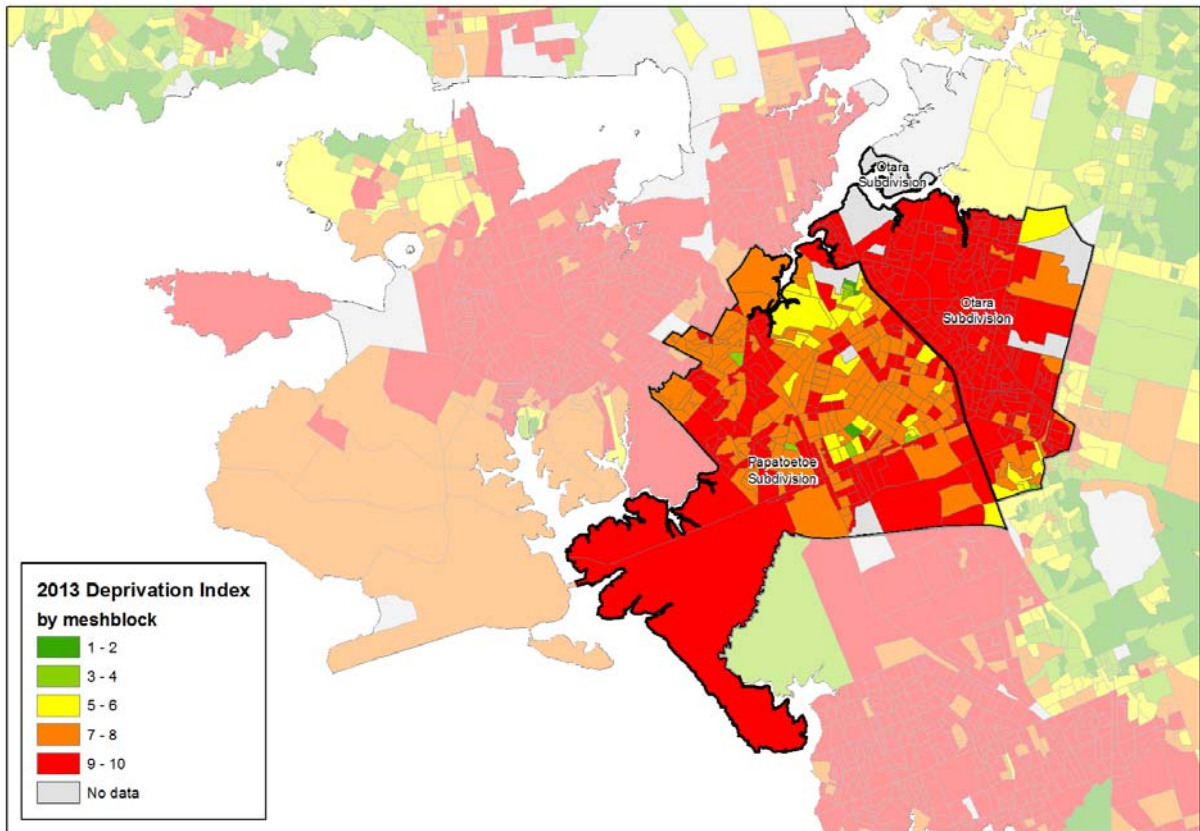
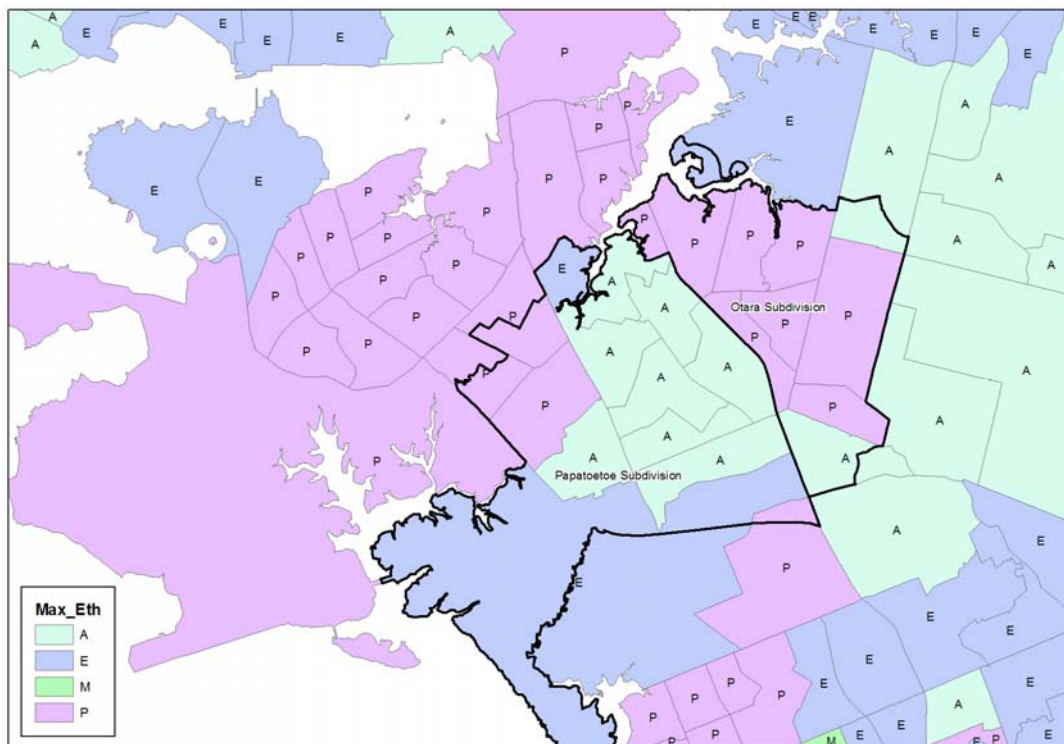


## Factors demonstrating differences between Ōtara and Papatoetoe communities
