**Re WESTERN SPRINGS TEMPORARY ALCOHOL BAN**

New Zealand Police would like to make a formal request for a recurring temporary alcohol ban to be imposed for an area around the venue of Western Springs Stadium and Park, Auckland.

The request is to have the temporary alcohol ban automatically imposed for any concert that is held within the stadium or the outer field(s).

The purpose of alcohol bans is to prevent patrons from consuming alcohol in the vicinity of the venue, prior to, during and after events.

Over recent years temporary alcohol bans have significantly assisted in curbing alcohol related harm and offending in public areas, including Western Springs.

Police request that the recurring temporary alcohol ban be imposed for a period of 2 years from the date of approval and would be activated from 7:00am on the day of the event until 7:00am the day following the conclusion of the events.

If this request is declined, Police would further request that individual temporary alcohol bans be imposed for the following events and dates with the same times as outlined above:

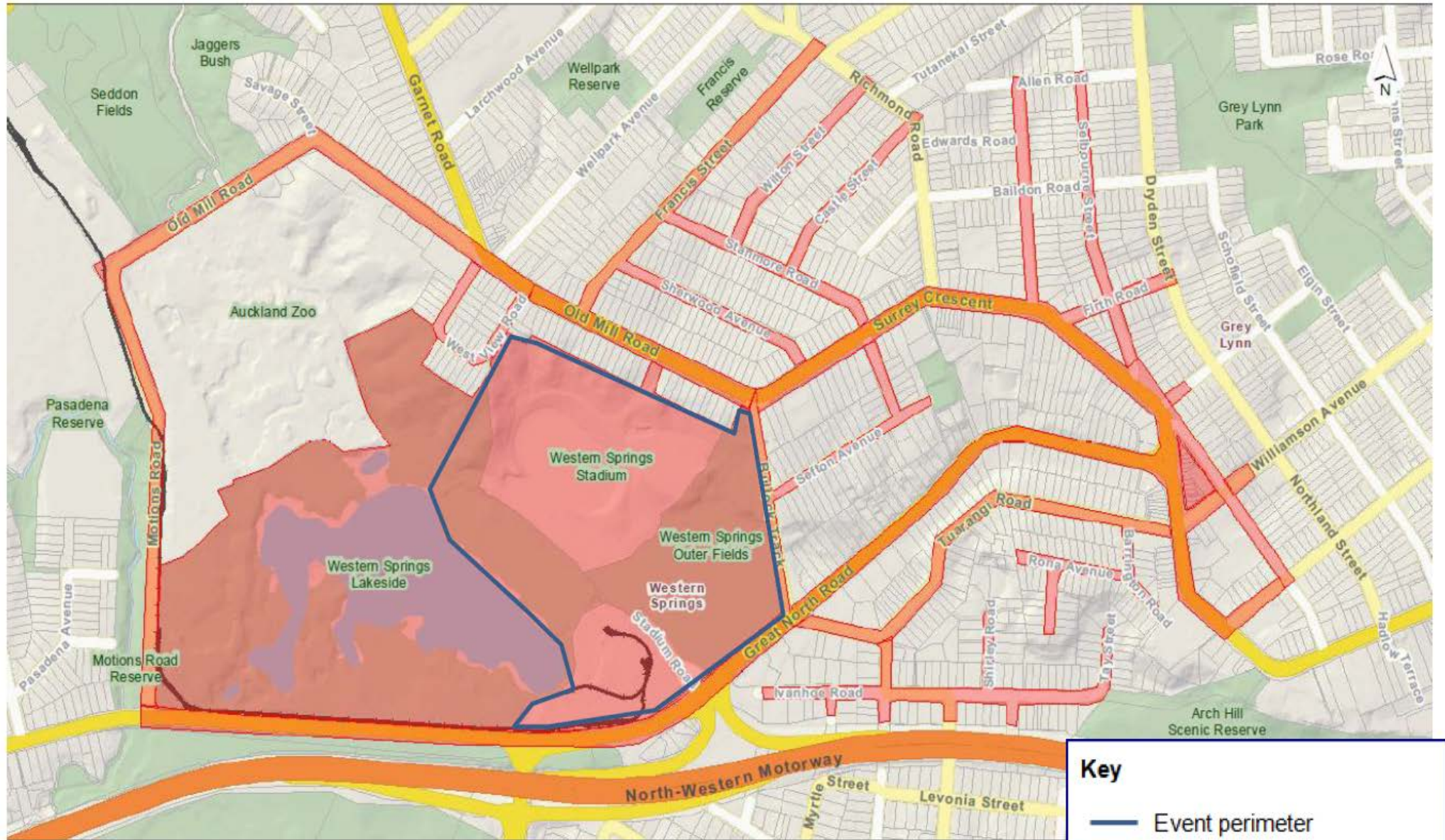
Friday Jams concert	Sunday 18 November 2018
Fat Freddie's Drop concert	Saturday 19 January 2019
Six 60 concert	Saturday 23 February 2019
