Checklist for determining if a Dog is an American Pit Bull Terrier Type

1. Photographs are to be taken at the time of assessment and are to be taken from the side, front and back with specific shots taken of any outstanding physical American Pit Bull Terrier type characteristics.
2. Photos required include: Neck to shoulder, head front side, shoulder, hind quarters, top line and tail set – good quality close up pictures required. Can take fewer pictures if able to include multiple features apart from one good side on picture which is compulsory.
3. **A Digital Camera** must be used for photographing dogs.
4. An authorised officer is to carry out an assessment of the dog and complete a checklist score sheet.
5. Each item on the checklist has a grading of 0 to 3. A grading of 0 indicates no compliance and a comment is required, 1 indicates part compliance, 2 indicates substantial compliance and 3 indicates full compliance.
- * 6. A total score of 1 to 45 indicates that the dog does not substantially meet the description of an American Pit Bull Terrier type.
- * 7. A total score of 46 to 63 points indicates that the dog substantially meets the description of an American Pit Bull Terrier type.
8. Two people must carry out the assessment and one person must be a Senior or Team Leader.
9. Rating must be appropriate for dog's age.
10. Use attached characteristics which follow.
