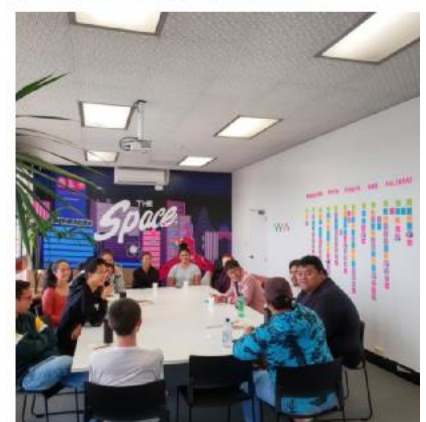
## 2019 Manurewa Youth Council Induction
