List of local parks and reserves in the Ōrākei Local Board area and recommended high-level kauri dieback mitigation measures

Park Name	Prioritisation Category	Kauri Dieback Status	Recommendation
Dingle Dell Reserve	A	Possibly Infected	Consider temporary closure until mitigation works are completed. Undertake detailed investigations to determine appropriate mitigation (upgrade, re-alignment, re-routing, other physical works) to prevent park becoming a source of infection.
Waiatarua Reserve	A	Non Symptomatic	Consider temporary closure until mitigation works are completed. Undertake detailed investigations to determine appropriate mitigation (upgrade, re-alignment, re-routing, other physical works) to protect kauri.
Ohinerau/Mt Hobson	C	Non Symptomatic	This park is administered by the Tupuna Maunga Authority, which must be engaged with to determine appropriate mitigation (upgrade, re-alignment, re-routing, other physical works) to protect kauri.
Ōrākei Domain B	C	Non Symptomatic	No mitigation.
St Johns Bush	C	Non Symptomatic	Install hygiene station(s) at strategic locations and consider barrier planting to prevent direct access to the tree and its roots.
Waiata Reserve	C	Non Symptomatic	No mitigation.
