EVENT SUMMARY

Place Des Anges is a 60 – 80 minute immersive experience and aerial performance. Cranes are used to support multi zipline wires (suspended from cranes, etc) from which the show's aerialists will perform, joined by giant inflatable cherubs, gymnasts and dancers, to drop feathers on the audience in each show.

The feathers used in Place des Anges are sourced from farms that meet strict European regulations regarding animal welfare. As per our previous events in the Domain this will be a family friendly event.

The show will take place over 4 nights on the upper sports fields of the Domain, with up to 15,000 public in attendance each night. Ticketholders will be given entry to the fenced site from 7pm, with the performance occurring at 8.30pm.

Numbers will be strictly controlled and there is no access to site without a ticket so that we can manage capacity. The company we are working with is Internationally acclaimed and highly experienced.

This work has been performed over 30 times world-wide, most recently WOMADelaide in 2018.
