### Argentine ant and Plague skink surveillance

Report being collated on 2015/16 works.

## Argentine & Darwin's ants

Working on monitoring the high-risk surveillance sites at the north end of the island. No new populations of Argentine ants found. Physical works are now completed and the report is being worked on

### Argentine ants-Thomas Road

Second treatment at sawmill site on Dave Hills property. Lot of ant activity observed during this treatment.

Sample of Ants brought in from the corner of Whangaparapara and French st were white footed house ants

## **Mulberry Grove Community Pest coordinator**

Rat capture is down with a total of 60 reported trapped up to the 8<sup>th</sup> August. A lot of people were away through the month and so didn't carry out trapping. Mice have been reported, including by Cathy who hasn't had mice before, and last month trapped 4 and the first week of August two.

Econode trap alert system is being trailed by Matt Way and Scott Sambal and it is hoped the system will eliminate a lot of the Labour needed for trapping. Devices are being modified to make them more corrosion resistant.

Sole source approved for the continuation of this programme

#### **West Coast Weed Surveillance**

Survey work has continued around the southern portion of the Tryphena harbour. Other than a Causuarina which appears to have spread by sea dispersal, there were not a lot of weeds of concern present. Surprisingly the coastline of the Tryphena was relatively weed free. A small number of pampas plants were present, and Cotoneaster has not spread as aggressively from Shoal Bay as would be expected. The Council and DOC reserve around the coast below Millers Hill only recorded a handful of pampas & 1 Cotoneaster so it would be straight forward to treat these while the size of the problems are small. Coast between Schooner Bay and Okupu to be visited to complete the survey.
