Cycling and walking options that make it easy to get around and through our area	<p>Albert Eden LB has funded improved pedestrian signals or crossing opportunities in the following locations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mt Eden Village • Valley Road • Gillies Avenue • Ranfurly Street • The Drive School Zone/Pedestrian Safety • Manukau Road <p>Albert Eden LB funded the provision of cycle racks at Kingsland Station.</p> <p>The Albert Eden LB funded new footpath in Cadman Street.</p> <p>Auckland Transport completed the Dominion Road parallel cycle routes to support cycling in the local board area.</p>
More people in Albert-Eden choose to use public transport	<p>Double Decker buses on Mt Eden Road have increased capacity on this route and increasing the hours of bus lane hour operation plus filling some gaps in the existing bus lane will also facilitate bus journey times.</p> <p>Bus lane operation hours and bus lane extensions will be rolled out on Sandringham Road from Mt</p>

	<p>Albert Road citybound which will also support quicker bus journey times.</p> <p>A proposed new bus lane on Great North Road through Waterview will improve journey times through this area.</p> <p>The Pah Road/Manukau Road transit lanes has improved bus travelling times for bus passengers on this route.</p> <p>Increases in train frequency on the western rail line have improved choices for passengers.</p> <p>The new overbridge at Mt Albert Station has also supported use of the Mt Albert Station.</p>
