1.0 First visit of Ward Governing Body member

Desley Simpson, the Ōrākei Ward Governing Body member was in attendance to meet with the Board to discuss how to work together in the new term.

2.0 Key projects / issues

Suzanne Weld briefed members on key local projects and issues of public interest across the local board, plus updated members on the Annual Plan and Local Board Plan processes between now and the year of the year.

3.0 Local Board Tour

4.0 Key external stakeholders and community engagement
