Resource Consent	Warren Avenue	<p>A development is occurring at Ranfurly Village located at 539 Mount Albert Road in Three Kings. As a result the development is required to improve an existing substandard vehicle crossing on Warren Avenue to an acceptable standard. Resulting from this change is the necessity to improve the safety and operational aspects of this vehicle crossing by implementing changes to the road markings on Warren Avenue.</p> <p>To ensure the traffic and parking controls are legally binding, a resolution from AT's traffic control committee is necessary.</p> <p>What is proposed?</p> <p>The changes to the road markings on Warren Avenue are detailed below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New "No Stopping at all Times" (NSAATs) lines are to be marked between the existing NSAAT lines from property 17 to a short distance past property 35. • The flush median on the approach to the signalised intersection of Warren Avenue and Mount Albert Road is to be extended. 	12 April 2017	<i>Board has no objection as long as affected residents are consulted. Traffic Operations	Pah Road	<p>Following on from the installation of the Transit Lane (T3) on Manukau and Pah Roads, AT has been actively monitoring and reporting on the performance of this new layout, and identifying any potential locations to accommodate resident parking. A number of parking spaces are now being proposed to be reinstated outside of the operating hours of the transit lane.</p> <p>There are three spaces in the Puketapapa LB area that will be made available in the vicinity of 80A Pah Road.</p>	26 April 2017	<i>Information only, no response required.</i>
