Jeff Jowsey – criterium cycle track at Green Road, Dairy Flat	Jeff Jowsey outlined a proposal for a criterium cycle track at council owned land at Green Road, Dairy Flat	The land at Green Road, Dairy Flat was purchased by the legacy Rodney District Council with a view to utilising it for a future sport ground/park. The land is currently administered by Panuku Development Auckland and there are a number of leases on the property, some of these leases to such groups as North Shore Model Aero Club and Silverdale Pony Club. There are currently no plans for comprehensive development of the site for sporting purposes. Such development is anticipated in the future and will involve liaison with the public, stakeholder groups and other neighbouring local boards etc.

The local board is supportive of the walkway/cycleway in principal but as it relates to funding application relate to the improvement of a council asset, current financial policy requires that this project proceed via a procurement process and not a grant. The local board have recommended that relevant staff work with the applicant to further this initiative via that process.
