Q2 What is one thing you think is missing in the Upper Harbour area, which you feel is extremely important for the future	More cycle lanes needed.
Q2 What is one thing you think is missing in the Upper Harbour area, which you feel is extremely important for the future	Our roads are congested. He tells his friends to not go to Albany in the weekends as the roads are too busy.
Q2 What is one thing you think is missing in the Upper Harbour area, which you feel is extremely important for the future	Traffic in the North Shore is too congested, both highways and local roads alike.
Q2 What is one thing you think is missing in the Upper Harbour area, which you feel is extremely important for the future	Lots of growth in Greenhithe - population more than doubled in last 10 years; lots of pressure on sporting clubs (also growing membership - expected to grow 100% over next 15 years) NZ Football has informed clubs there are to be no more clubs - actually reduce from 400 down to 300; aim is for clubs to be more professional and better scale (e.g. some clubs only have 1 team); existing clubs must develop plans to determine how to cater for growth 460 kids for 17/18, largest community group in Greenhithe (1 in 5 kids in school in Greenhithe are GFC members) - good relationship with council No access to grounds in Dec, Jan, Feb and March due to field management (season starts 1 Apr) and need to protect pitches; little access to run trials in lead up to season - have mixed access to various parks, but put so much pressure on the parks that its damaging the spaces Would like to move into more serious competitions - current fields are not the right size, and supporting infrastructure do not meet requirements Solution - replace rugby field at Wainoni with artificial playing surface. Need to remove cricket pitch in the middle of rugby field
Q5 Do you have any further comments about our proposed local board plan	Albany Library - Multi functional with a fast turnaround of books/CDs. A bigger space or area where children could be separate would be helpful as they can be a distraction.
Q5 Do you have any further comments about our proposed local board plan	Road at Pannill Place is especially narrow, leading to cars parking on footpath after work hours and during weekends. This creates a safety issue for children who wish to walk on the footpaths. Yellow lines for Pannill Place.
Q5 Do you have any further comments about our proposed local board plan	More parking at Albany Park and Ride, no available parking space sometimes forces constituent to drive straight to the city instead

Q5 Do you have any further comments about our proposed local board plan	Albany Stadium Pools is too small, expectation was for a facility comparable in size to the pools at Glenfield. Initial assumption was that the size was to avoid competing with commercial pools
