		Local Board Plan feedback For a small part of land surrounded by water it's really important that Waiheke has an indoor pool where children can learn water safety all year round.
		Local Board Plan Feedback, A heated indoor swimming pool is essential for an island this size. It would benefit all ages and all physical and mental conditions.
		Local Board Plan Feedback: It is my belief that Waiheke needs a community pool which is indoor and heated. This will provide huge benefits to the community at large and will be a facility beneficial to all ages and abilities from children learning to swim to older people swimming for fitness or enjoyment.

		<p>Local Board Plan Feedback: Waiheke needs an indoor heated community swimming pool because it is an island and we need the community to be able to swim. All ages of the community would be able to benefit from school children to the elderly and disabled. The school pool was unavailable for use last summer and as a result there was no public swimming pool available. The pool needs to be indoor so that it can be used for 12 months of the year. If children who are learning to swim, only swim in the summer then at the start of each summer season the first month is spent getting them up to the standard that they were at the end of the previous summer. Please verify this with any of the swimming instructors on the island. The provision of a publicly available swimming pool will aid the elderly on the island as a gentle accessible form of exercise and will also aid the injured and the disabled on the island who no longer will have to travel to Auckland for hydrotherapy. The indoor heated community swimming pool needs to be built so that it is commercially viable and not become a "white elephant". As such the Waiheke Community Pool Society Inc's proposal of a public / private partnership needs to be investigated and considered by the Waiheke Local Board and Auckland Council. By the inclusion of other revenue generating spaces, the indoor heated community swimming pool would become a hub for families and the community on the island.</p> <p>Local Board Plan Feedback: indoor heated swimming pool community access all times please</p> <p>Local Board Plan Feedback: Waiheke needs an indoor heated community swimming pool.
