

Attachment A – Summary of local board engagement on the Auckland Plan Refresh

February and April 2017	Local boards held cluster briefings to provide feedback and information which was used to refine the scope of strategic themes and focus areas.
April 2017	Local board cluster briefings were held on the Development Strategy.
June and July 2017	A report on the Auckland Plan Refresh was considered at local board business meetings at which they considered their formal position on the themes and focus areas.
July 2017	Local board cluster briefings were held on the Development Strategy.
1 August 2017	Resolutions and feedback from local board workshops informed the further development of a draft strategic framework, and approved in principle by the Planning Committee on 1 August.
August 2017	A further update on the Auckland Plan refresh was sent by memo to local boards regarding next steps for further engagement in September 2017.
September 2017	Local boards reviewed the Auckland Plan package of materials which included content across the six outcome areas and the Development Strategy. Local boards provided feedback through their business meeting resolutions. This feedback is being considered as part of the draft content for the proposed Auckland Plan.

Local board chairs or their representatives have been invited to all Planning Committee workshops on the Auckland Plan. There have been 20 workshops to date since February 2017 with further workshops scheduled to the end of the year.
