The board requested review of speed limits be prioritised for MacKenzie Rd, Waiau Pa, and Hunua Village as sites of on-going concern. Staff provided an update on the rural signage project including a recent audit of initial signage erected which saw 156 signs removed in Ararimu and Hunua. Future installations will have a traffic engineer assigned to monitor installation. The board reiterated concern regarding glare and positioning of signage on rural roads.
