FWPF18-04	<b>Planting wet corner adjacent to mauku stream</b>	<p>Our land is opposite de waterfall gardens and is alongside the Mauku stream, together with Whakaupoko and Fiona McDonald we planted an unnamed tributary to the mauku stream 6 years ago. I myself grew a lot of native trees and planted hill sides of our property and the banks of the Mauku stream. There is still a part that is regularly overflowing and wet so not suitable for grazing. We like to fence this off and plant. The area is in between the previously planted tributary and the Mauku stream. The area is about 15 by 30 meter. We will take care of the fencing, planting, weed control if necessary.
