Dear Adela

Good to touch base with you earlier today regarding this proposal. As I mentioned we are most concerned that the proposal is to sell the reserve (once the status is changed) on the open market.

We understand that it is not possible to build anything on this site as large amounts of concrete were dumped there when large roadworks were undertaken some years ago - perhaps around 2008 or 2009. I don't remember the exact year. We saw that a small layer of soil was placed over top of the large amounts of concrete debris.

As an immediate neighbour of this land we are concerned that it is used for only what it is fit for. Last time the works were carried out on that land our house shook for months (it was a long project) and cracks developed. If Panuku's plan is to remove the debris so it can be sold, we would be most concerned for any further damage to our house.

I look forward to discussing the proposal with the person you mentioned.
