| Manurewa | <p>In 2019/2020, we plan to invest \$5.5 million to renew and develop assets and \$13 million to maintain and operate assets as well as provide local programmes and initiatives.</p> <p>We will continue to deliver the projects you have already identified as being local priorities through the 2017 Local Board Plan, and we are not proposing major changes to existing budgets or work programmes for 2019/2020.</p> <p>Our focus has been working alongside residents, community groups and local business owners to help build pride in Clendon. We would like to continue our collective approach to the ongoing revitalisation of the Clendon town centre and surrounding area, as well as developing nearby Keith Park as a destination site.</p> <p>Following community feedback, the board has made it a priority to ensure that, where possible, our playgrounds and play spaces are accessible, disability friendly and cater for older people who are out and about.</p> <p>You also told us that you are concerned about transport issues, including the lack of safety on our local roads. We will build on our work to improve access and safety at Te Mahia station and will introduce traffic calming measures in several locations.</p> <p>In response to your concerns about the environment, we will support community-led practical responses to reducing waste, and maintain our collaborative work on the restoration of our streams.</p> <p>We remain committed in our advocacy to address illegal dumping, including the reintroduction of the traditional inorganic collection, and for south Auckland to be a priority for a Community Recycling Centre.</p> |
