### Attachment 1 – Draft Landscape Concept for Opaheke Sports Park, 2012



- 1 Proposed sports fields including 8 full sized senior playing fields, 5 cricket pitches and 1 training field
- 2 Proposed changing facility. Sized to include 4 changing rooms, 2 public toilets and a referees room
- 3 Proposed main carpark, including amenity planting and footpaths (150 carparks and 6 accessible parks OR 138 carparks, 6 bus parks and 6 disabled parks). NB: Dashed line shows bus parking
- 4 Potential secondary carpark, including amenity planting and footpaths (70 carparks OR 59 carparks and 6 bus parks).
- 5 Existing Pony Club parking retained
- 6 Proposed playground (1600m<sup>2</sup>)
- 7 Proposed parkland walkway
- 8 Proposed pedestrian bridge and future connection to Great South Road via former golf course land
- 9 Proposed footpath to be connected to an existing footpath on Opaheke Road
- 10 Existing shelterbelt in decline, to be progressively replaced with replacement species
- 11 Potential park road to be formed if proceeding with secondary carpark option
- 12 Proposed 20m wide riparian planting
- 13 Proposed 2m wide creek planting with crossing points, to be determined by Pony Club
- 14 Proposed native trees (e.g Kahikatea, Totara, Rimu, Tanekaha, Matai)
- 15 Proposed specimen trees to buffer prevailing wind
- 16 Existing post and rail fence to be repaired and repainted
- 17 Proposed post and wire fence
- 18 Proposed equestrian precinct and stock grazing, concept for this area to be prepared by the Pony Club
- 19 Possible future train stop. Land owned by KiwiRail
- 20 Proposed pedestrian bridge and future connection to Great South Road via Gatland Road, using the existing 'paper road' designation
- 21 Site boundary
