Background:

The North Shore Times newspaper published an article on Tuesday, November 26, 2019 indicating that the business case for the Additional Waitemata Harbour Connection (AWHC) won't be published until mid-2020. .The article indicates that both Auckland Council and AT have been "in the loop" on the deliberations of NZTA.



I believe it is in our interests to have our views made known to NZTA.


Recommendations:
