<b>Kaipātiki Local Board</b>	
In 2020/2021 we plan to invest \$12.6 million to renew and develop assets and \$18.6 million to maintain and operate assets as well as provide local programmes and initiatives.	
<b>What we've been doing</b> <p>Each year we deliver activities and services in your local board area. These are based on our Local Board Plan, which sets our three-year direction for the local board.</p> <p>In 2019/2020 we installed shadesails over the playgrounds in Little Shoal Bay reserve, Shepherds Park, and Inwards reserve in line with our Sunsmart initiative, and have plans for future sites. We've also completed the first round of public consultation for our omnibus local parks management plan.</p> <p>We adopted the Birkenhead War Memorial Park Master Plan and will be heading straight into the development of the detailed business case for a multi-use sport facility.</p>	<b>Our proposed priorities for 2020/2021</b> <p>Continue to deliver events that celebrate aspects of our diverse community, install additional shadesails, develop the Glenfield Centre plan, progress stage one of the Beach Haven coastal connection, and continue maintaining our public spaces.</p> <p>Prevent the spread of kauri dieback in our local reserves by delivering the kauri dieback mitigation work programme together with our community environment volunteer groups.</p> <p>Complete the Local Parks Management Plan in 2020 to help guide the use, enjoyment, maintenance and development of local reserves.</p> <p>We're not proposing major changes to existing work programmes for 2020/2021 as we continue to deliver the projects identified in our Local Board Plan.</p>
