In accordance with Standing Order 2.5, I hereby give notice that I wish to move the following motion at the Tuesday 10 December 2019 business meeting of the Devonport-Takapuna Local Board:

Background:

For some years the parking on the Auburn Reserve has been allowed for 180 minutes between 8.00am – 6.00pm Monday – Friday. This is an inner CBD area, and the reserve's carpark is filled by 7.30am by all-day parkers, many of whom swap parking spaces during the day to avoid enforcement. Adjacent apartment owners also use the reserve's carparking, especially at weekends.

There are approximately 60 car parks on this dedicated reserve which are intended to serve the users of the park. The regular users include the Takapuna Play Centre, who require 10 carparks daily; PHAB, who require 3 mobility carparks plus 5 for their staff; Taitamariki Guide Centre, which has found that its use as a conference/course venue is now seriously inhibited due the lack of available car parking; and the Takapuna Croquet Club, which requires at least 10 carparks


At our last business meeting on November 19th the President of the Takapuna Croquet Club, Anne Mortimer, presented an analysis of the current situation suggesting that the parking for the entire reserve be revamped, similar to the example shown below, allowing for carparking for 60 minutes at all times only Permit Holders Exempt.



Recommendations:


That the Devonport-Takapuna Local Board:
