Regarding the name proposal for this area, Nga Maunga Whakahii o Kaipara would like the following consideration;

Taupaki meaning - "The Binding Peace"

This korero derives from a few major pakanga (battles) the first being Te Raupatu tihore in which Ngati Whatua sought utu (revenge) For previous killings by the people of Kawerau. Another battle between Ngati Whatua and Waiohua was fought in the Waitakere ranges, Ngati Whatua won this battle and returned to South Kaipara. Although closely related the Kawerau people did not take part in this battle. The Kawerau people settled near the cliffs north of Te Henga beach hence the name Te Taupaki "The binding peace". There was a peace settlement between Maki's great grandson Te Au o Te Whanua and Ngati Whatua Chief Poutapuaka hence the mis located name Taupaki (there is no Te in the name Taupaki).

Below are a couple of names that have significance to the area.

Rongomau - Peace, peace settlement, agreement

Houkura - Intact, Peaceful, undisturbed

Whawhau – Peaceful, Make piece
