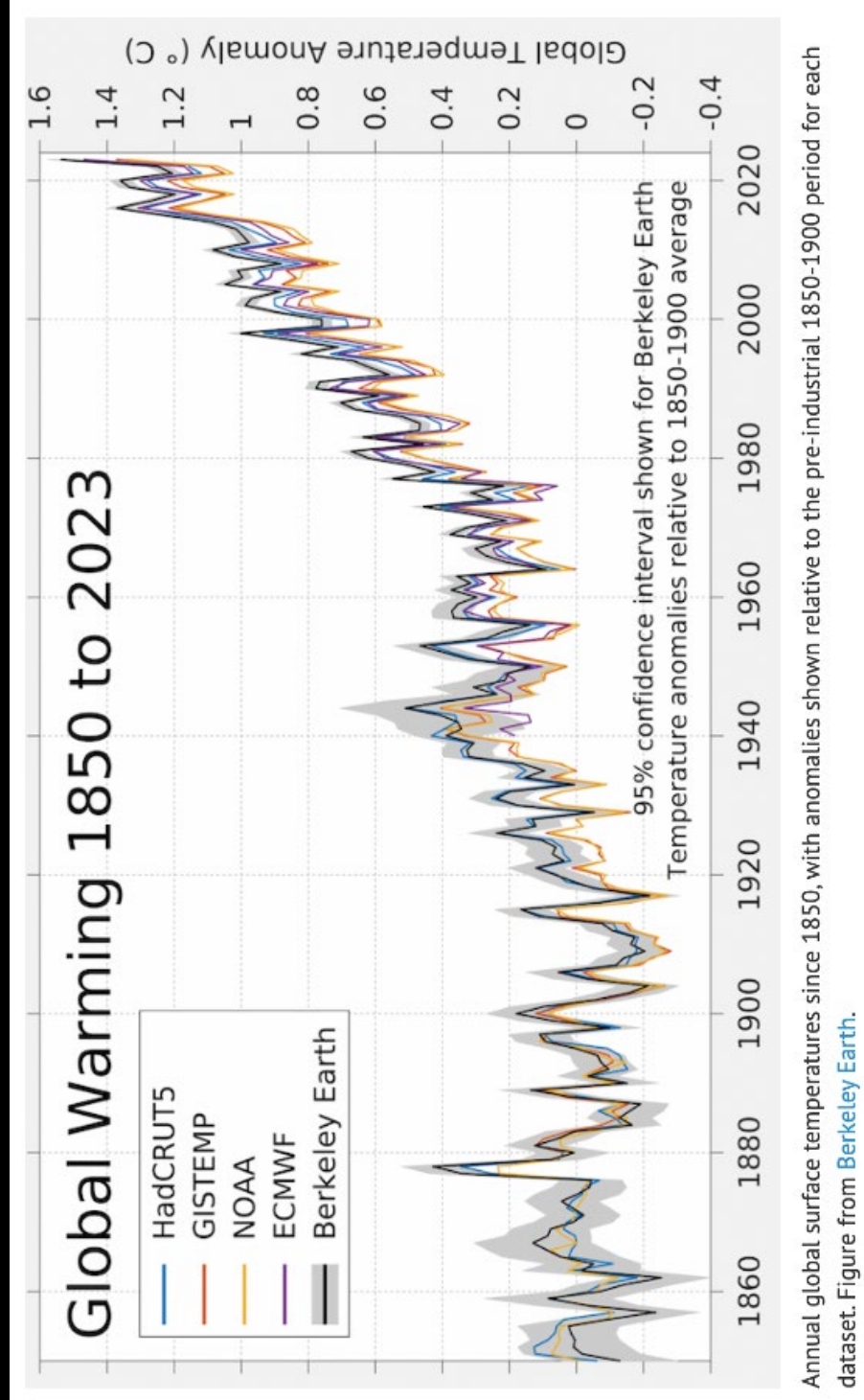

Auckland January 2023 floods cost

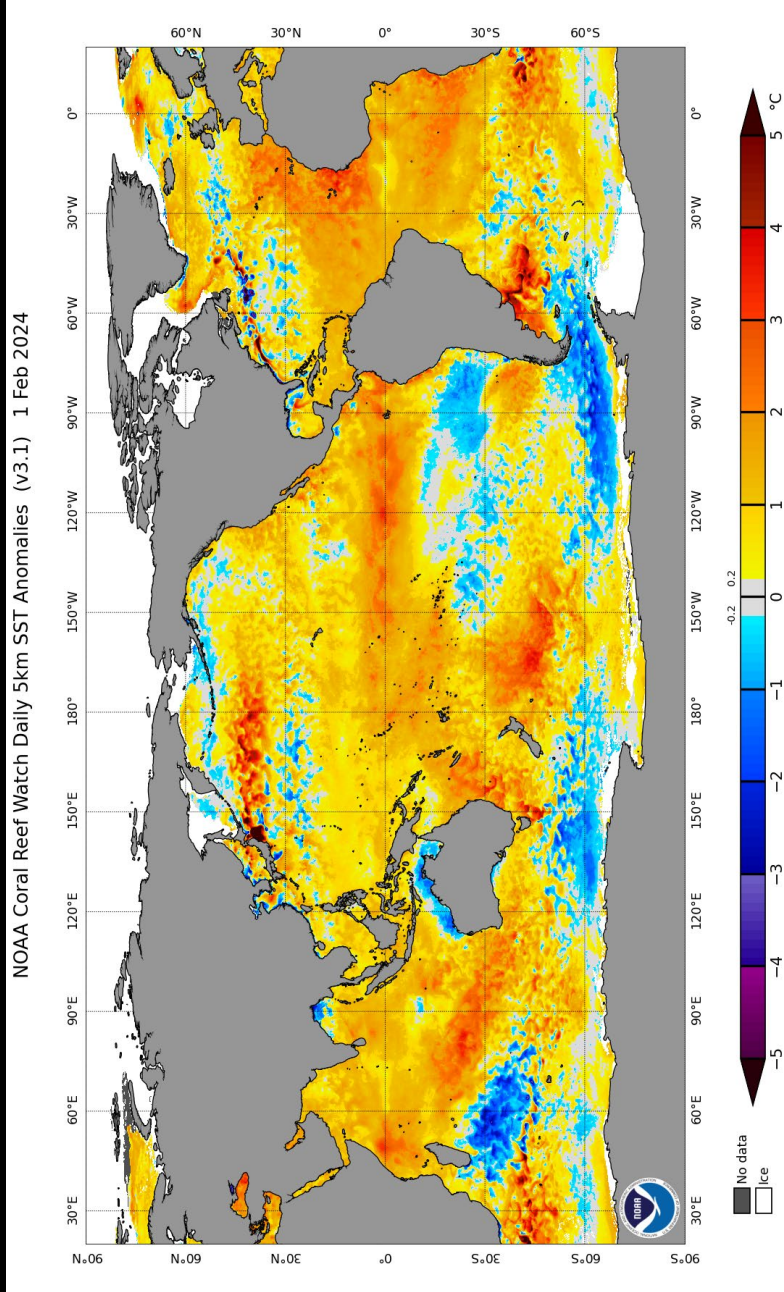
- 4 people died;
- 600 in emergency accommodation
- 10,000 properties flooded
- 7000 damaged properties (3000 seriously)
- >2000 slips
- 13,600 insurance claims
- An estimated \$1.2billion direct cost
- \$2 billion for recovery projects
- \$1.5 billion in 50,000 insurance claims
