The Kaipātiki Local Board would like to acknowledge the sudden and premature passing of Toni Shepherd and offer condolences to the Shepherd family.

Toni was a leader in children's health and for Māori. Toni was at the forefront of guiding Māori health at Starship through the recent health reforms and the pandemic in her role as the Director for Māori within Starship hospital. She recently wrote the Starship hospitals first strategy for improving Māori children's and whanau's health outcomes.

Toni has a background as working as a psychotherapist. Her passion was working with children with complex mental health needs. Toni was able to combine this with her desire to improve the health experience for Māori. From her own personal experiences having triplets whose health was fragile she understood the challenges that Māori families faced when accessing health services. From that experience Toni established a multi-disciplinary team Ringa Atawhai. This was a team of health professionals that were able to provide wrap around cultural support to families who were in Starship.

Toni was dedicated to her family and our community. Toni was a young mother who was very well known in the Birkenhead community. Toni and her husband Wiremu had four daughters. One set of triplets who are now all studying at Auckland University. Her youngest daughter went to Birkenhead Primary, Birkdale Intermediate and is in her first year at Northcote college.

Locally Toni will be remembered for her commitment to anything her children were involved with and our community. Toni was the mum who coached the netball teams, coached the rippa rugby team, played a massive part in supporting kids learn to how to be surf lifesavers at Murrays Bay surf club. Any time Birkenhead Primary School had a Kapa Haka event Toni was there helping with preparation.

Toni was on the Northcote Rugby club committee that organised the 2023 rugby tour. Her skill in working with children helped ensure this tour was a success.

The Kaipātiki Local Board are deeply saddened by Toni Shepherds passing and extends its condolences to her whanau and many friends within Kaipātiki.
