Tena Koutou Katoa,

An exciting international, black-comedy film has chosen to shoot their next film 'Heart Eyes' (production title) in Tāmaki Makaurau / Auckland.

Synopsis

When the Heart Eyes Killer strikes Seattle, a pair of co-workers pulling overtime on Valentine's Day are mistaken for a couple by the elusive couple-hunting killer. Now they must spend the most romantic night of the year running for their lives.

Filming Areas (night shoots)

- Wintergarden (courtyard interior)
- Wintergarden Road
- Park area either side of The Crescent near the Wintergarden and towards the band rotunda

Roads - for technical support & to support the scenes

Streets under road closure or traffic management of some kind: Domain Drive, The Crescent, Wintergarden Road, Kiosk Road, Football Road, Museum Circuit, Maunsell Road Extension, Little George Street, Grandstand Road.

Road closures are requested to be able to portray the Domain if it were in the USA. The production aims to minimise the possibility of cars and/or headlights on the wrong side of the road being visible in the background of shots. Shooting with the roads open would require waiting for ordinary vehicles to pass, and increase the total time needed on site.

Closing the roads would allow the production to work alongside AT to control the street lighting. It is common practice for productions to substitute lighting to suit the setting required in terms of hue (colour) and throw (direction).

Emergency vehicles

At all times, emergency vehicles must be able to move through the roads. Traffic Management Plans stipulate that emergency services must pass through.

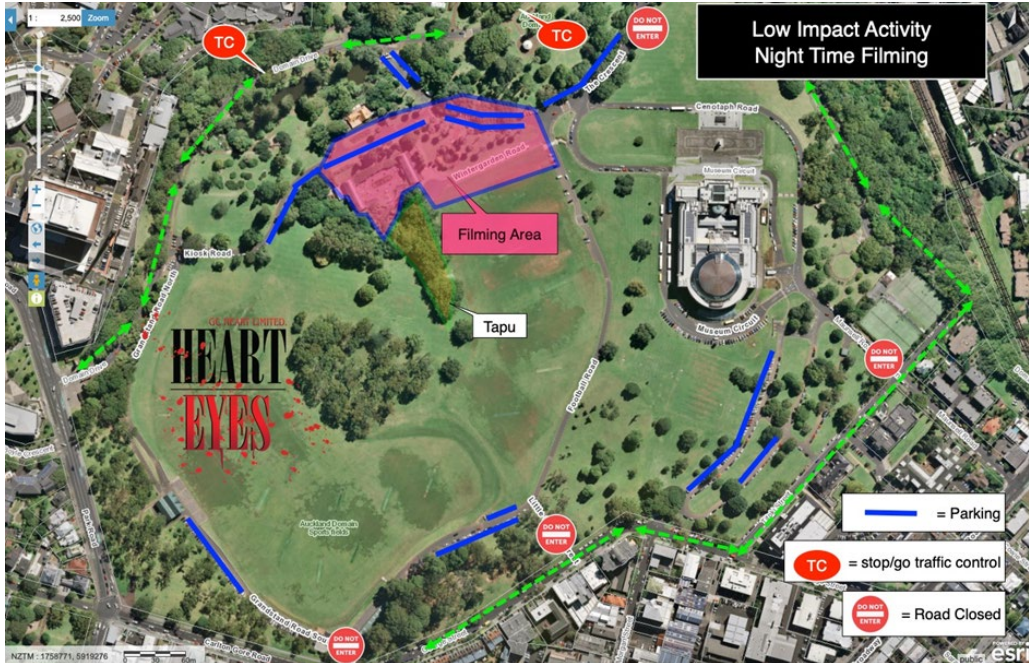
No actual filming activity is planned to occur on any travel routes through the Domain. Consultation with Auckland Hospital is underway.

- Car parking during the night within the open-air museum parking. Parallel to Titoki Street.
- Unit base (temporary catering and amenities for cast and crew) within the museum open-air parking. Near the south entrance. Subject to change if a more suitable site is established.
