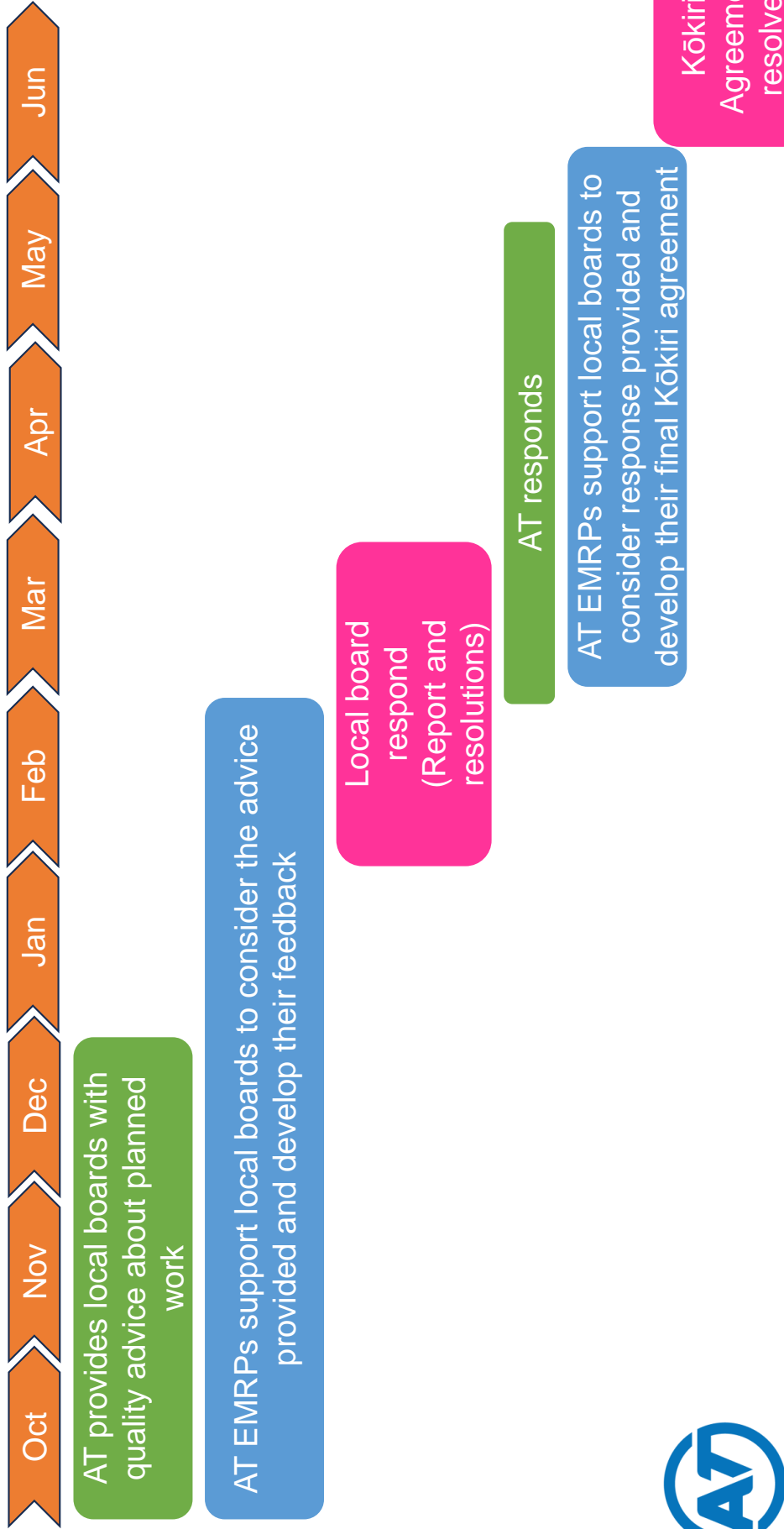



The terms we use
