## Local Board Capital Transport Fund

That the Papakura Local Board:

- a) whiwhi / receive the report from Auckland Transport titled Local Board Transport Capital Fund (LBTCF) projects. ~~and consider its recommendations in Attachment A.~~
- b) tuhi tīpoka / note that \$628,296 of additional Local Board Transport Capital Fund is available for allocation.
- c) whakaae / approve the following allocations of the Local Board Transport Capital Fund:
  - i) \$625,299 - Settlement / Marne Road intersection improvements
  - ii) \$2,997 - to complete the bus shelter project.
- d) whakaae / agree that should funds become available the following projects be progressed:
  - i) Redcrest Avenue crossing - \$375,000
  - ii) McLennan Park pathway one (McLennan Park to Battalion Drive) - \$226,000





## Extra-ordinary item - Storm Affected Land Use Policy Report



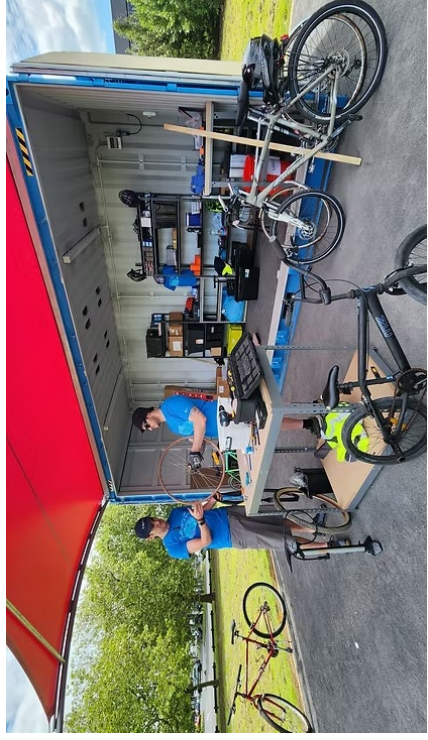
- Briefing on 3 Feb 2025, email sent 14 Feb 2025 with the draft policy attached
- Deadline for feedback - 5pm Thursday 27 February 2025
- Council purchasing around 1,200 residential properties
- Management of properties includes three key components:
  - interim maintenance and risk management
  - the house removal programme, and the
  - storm affected land use programme to determine appropriate future uses.
- The policy identifies that land will be either:
  - divested to another party
  - transferred within the Auckland Council Group to meet an identified service need, or
  - held by the council where the land is assessed as being highly hazardous.

- \$100,000 set up funding is no longer available

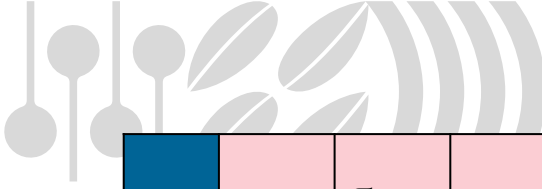

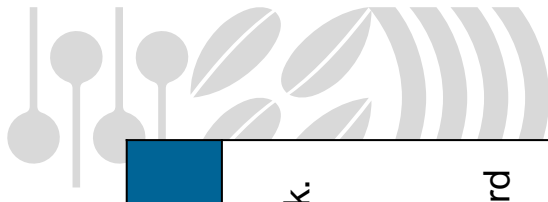
