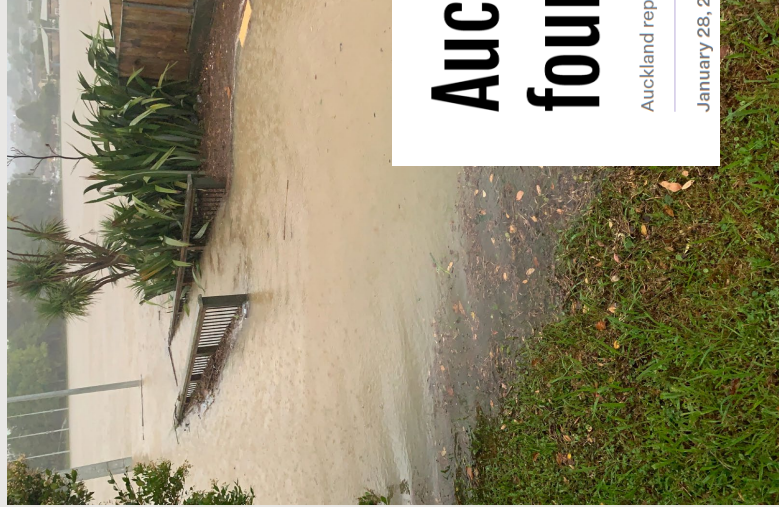

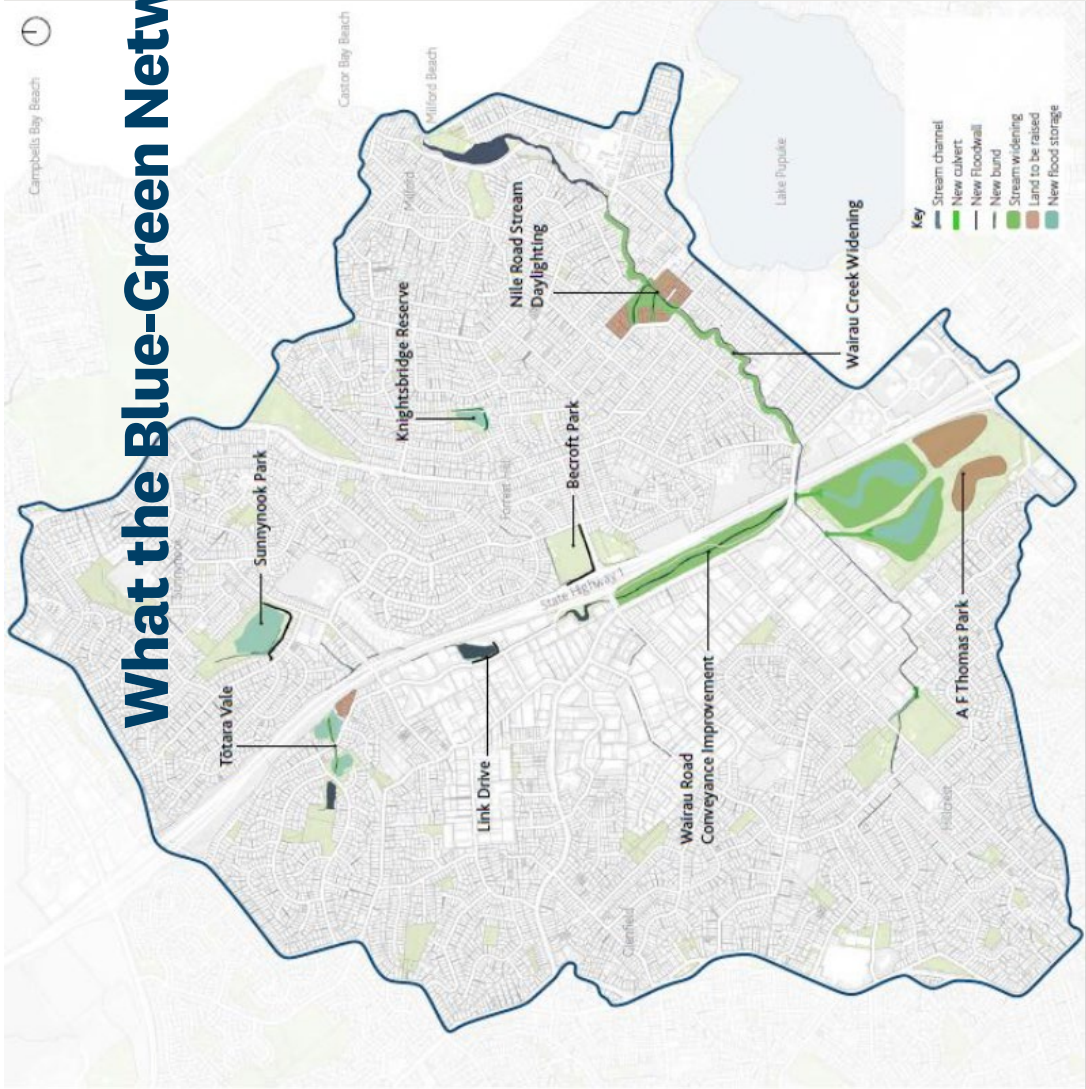

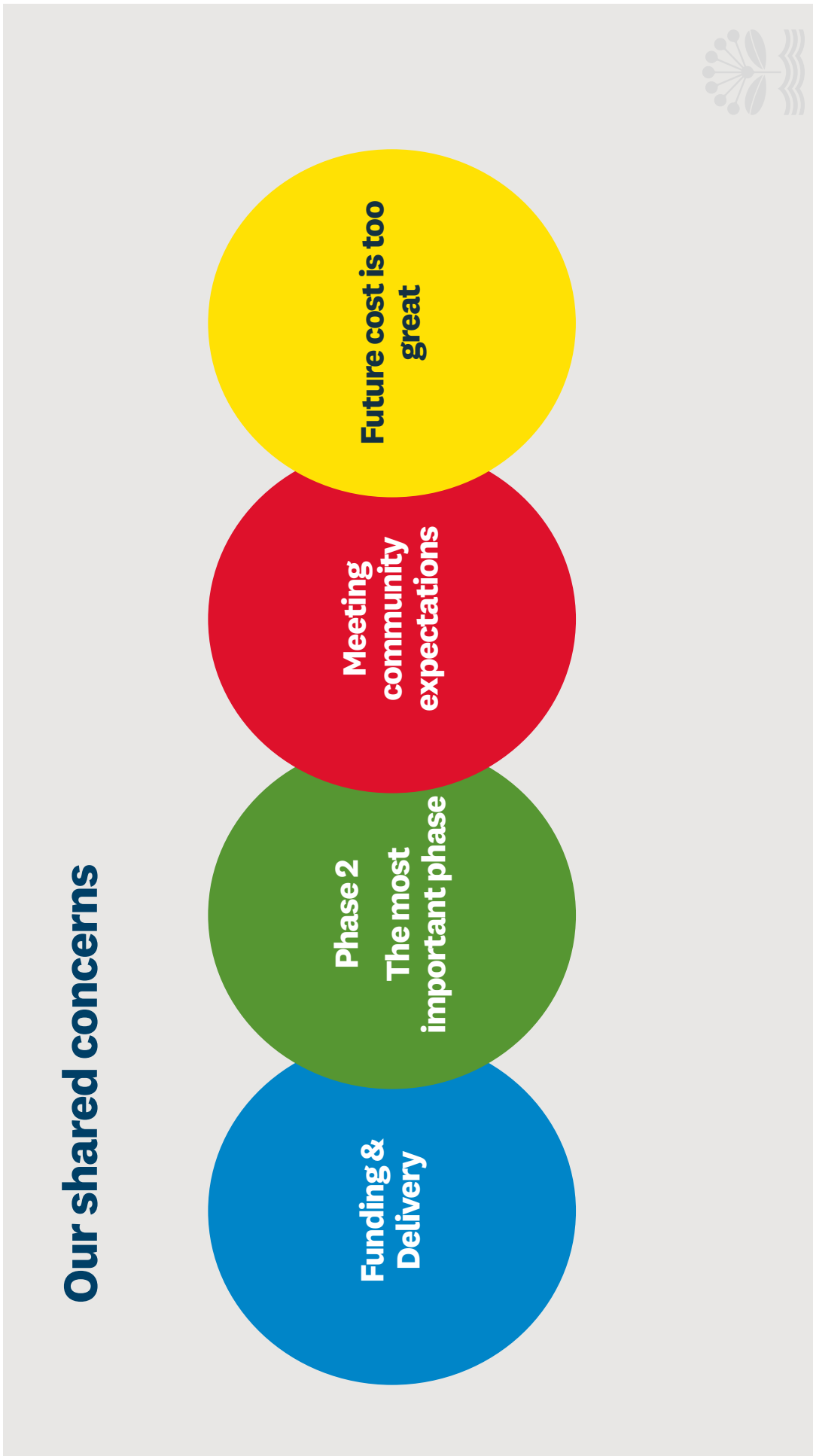


# Risk to critical infrastructure North Shore Hospital
