Focused on delivering a community orientated all purpose cricket environment for all players and their families



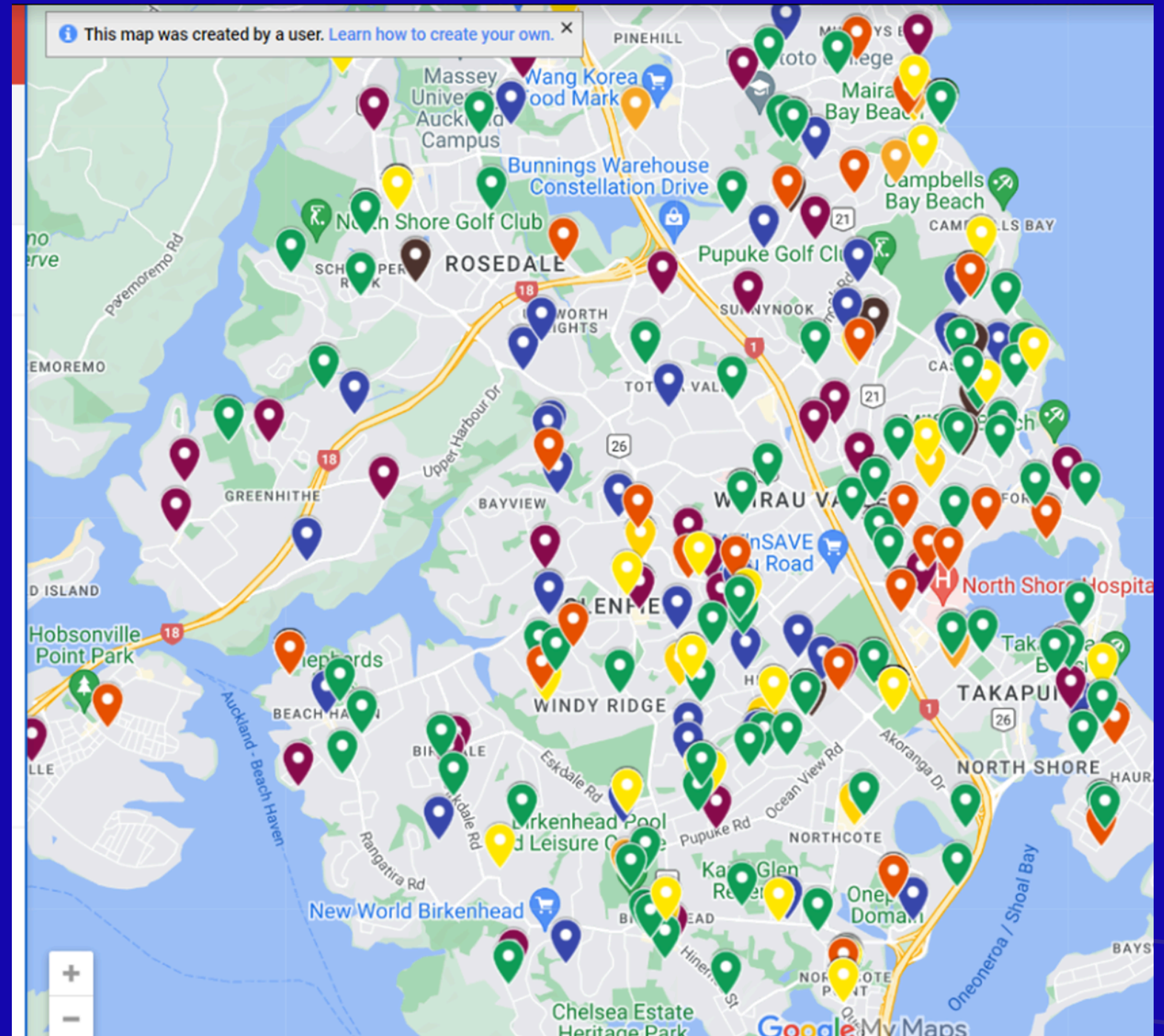
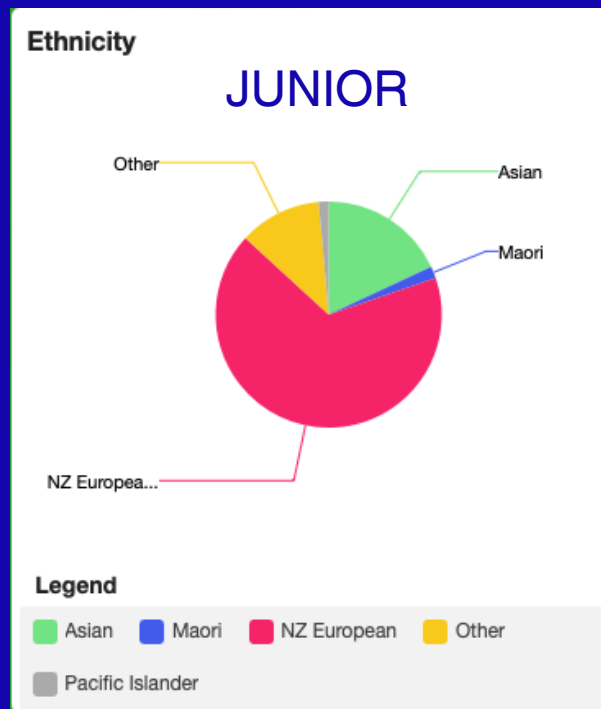
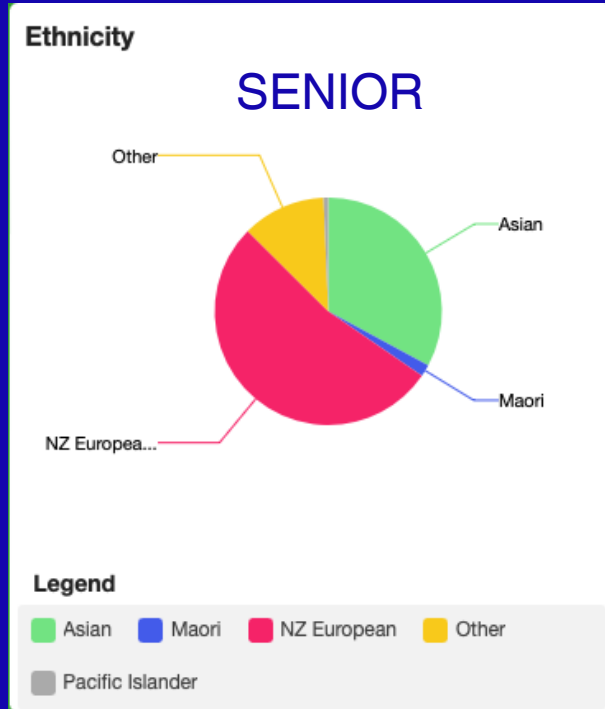
