Project background

Context & scope:

- Request from the Upper Harbour LB to implement some wayfinding signage similar to other boards who have successfully implemented wayfinding projects.
- Importance of scalable solutions tailored to available funding, suburb by suburb.
- Wayfinding signs that go up by walkways, cut throughs (street to street connections) and at park entrances where a path goes through and out to another road.
- Start at Fairview/Oteha / Harrowglen subdivisions scope by Wayfinding team and internal cost estimates.



Implementation Plan

Phase 1: Fairview / Oteha and Harrowglen subdivisions

- Identify existing walkways and parks which have street connections and are accessible by foot or bicycle. (Sourced existing asset database)
- Walkways need to have clear sight view with no trees or structures obstructing the paths.
- Signage placed close to footpath in line with street blade standards and not obstructing footpath.

Scaling for Future Phases:

- Expand the wayfinding initiative to additional suburbs as funding allows.
- Review feedback from locals and adjust process or approach for next phases.
